Call for Nominations

Award selections are based on, but not limited to, the nominee's volunteer efforts, commitment of time, programmatic accomplishments, financial impact, and overall support of EPHM's Mission.

Selection Process: Nominations are accepted from El Paso Holocaust Museum Members in good standing only. Nominations will be presented to EPHM's Executive Committee who will select the top three to four nominations to present to EPHM's full Board of Directors, who will then review and vote on those outstanding nominations.
